BY PLANE

Avignon airport

www.avignon.aeroport.fr

The airport is located 8 km south of the town centre. Connection to the town centre by bus line 3 or 21 (bus stops about 1.5 km from airport) or by taxi. There are direct plane connections from Avignon to various cities in the United Kingdom, operated by two low cost airlines, Flybe and Jet2. <http://www.flybe.com> or <http://www.jet2.com>.

Marseille-Provence airport

This airport is located 80 km south of Avignon. It connects to most large European cities.

This airport has a new low-cost terminal called « mp² », with flights to various European and Moroccan destinations.

To get to Avignon, take the navette (shuttle bus) from the airport to the Marseille-St. Charles train station. From there, take the train to Avignon. You can also rent a car at the airport and drive to Avignon.

Nîmes-Arles-Camargue airport

This airport is located 50 km west of Avignon. From there, you can fly from/to Brussels, London Luton and Liverpool with RyanAir.

To get to Avignon, take the navette (shuttle bus) from the airport to the Nîmes train station. From there, take the train to Avignon. You can also rent a car at the airport and drive to Avignon.

Other airports

There are several ways of getting to Avignon via a stop-over at another French airport.

Paris airports (Roissy-Charles de Gaulle and Orly): www.aeroportsdeparis.fr

Roissy-Charles de Gaulle has a TGV (high-speed train) station that connects directly to Avignon. .

From Orly, there are daily flights to Avignon, or you can take a TGV train from Paris (Gare de Lyon) town centre.

Lyon St. Exupéry airport: www.lyon.aeroport.fr

200 km to the north of Avignon, there is a TGV (high-speed train) line that connects the airport directly to the TGV station in Avignon.

BY TRAIN

If you travel by train, you must buy and punch (“*composter*” in French) your train ticket before getting on the train!

Please note that there are two train stations in Avignon:

1-Gare TGV (located in the suburb). Direct TGV trains from Paris (*Gare de Lyon* and *Charles de Gaulle* airport), Lille, Brussels, Geneva.... Buses (called “*navette*”) connect to central Avignon in 15-20 minutes. Ticket price: € 1.20, to buy on the bus.

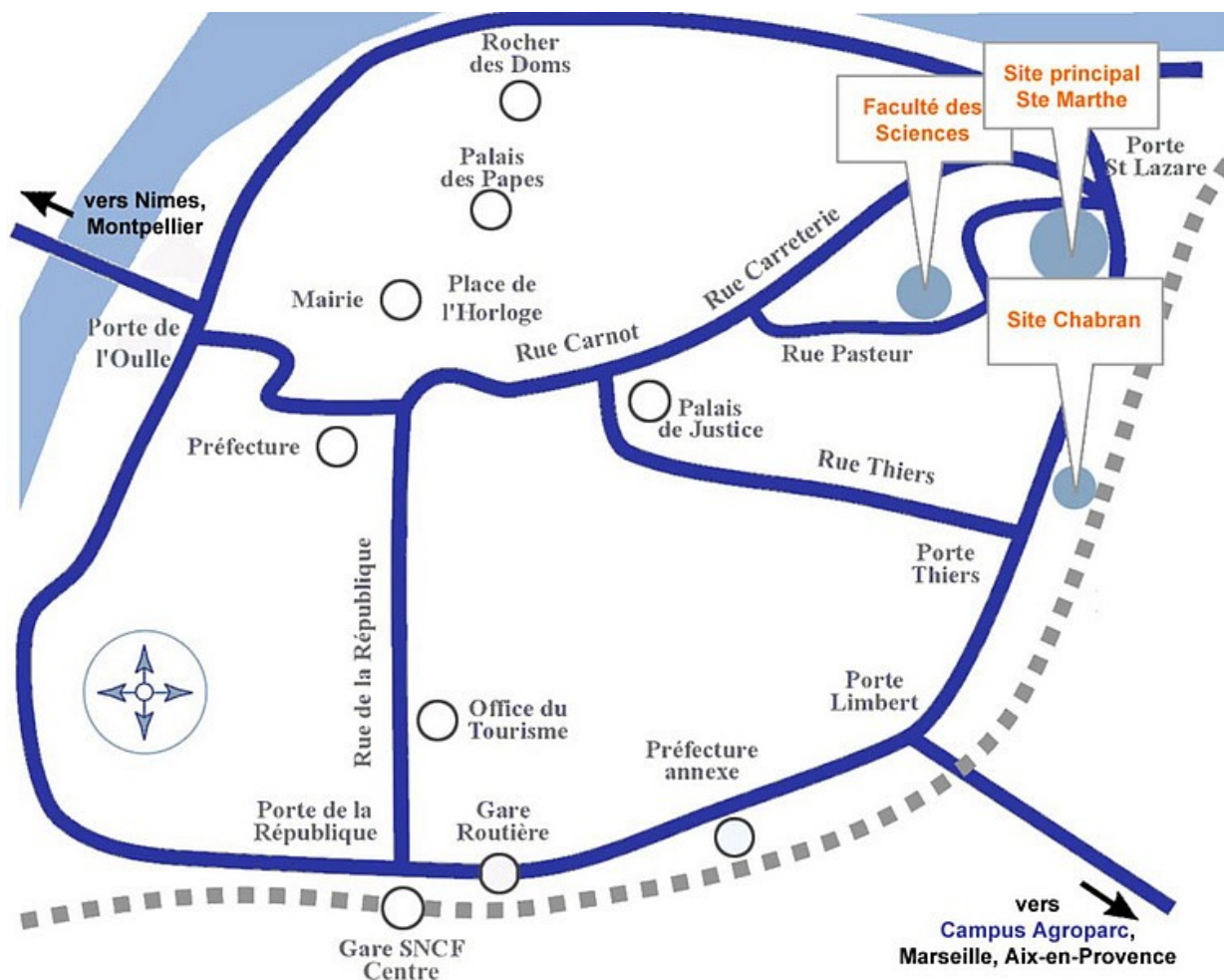
2-Gare centre S.N.C.F., boulevard Saint-Roch, (located in the town centre).

BY BUS

Buses generally run from 6 am until 8 pm. The bus service is less frequent during the weekend and during school holidays.

Lines 7 and 30 go directly from the train station "centre" to the main campus of the University (stop "Université").

BY TAXI

Taxis 24/24 h. Phone +33 (0)4 90 82 20 20. Please note: Payment in cash only.

BY CAR

A7 motorway exit 23 "Avignon Nord", then D225 direction Avignon, then exit "Avignon Centre", then left direction "Université".

Free car park: Parking des Italiens (5 minutes' walk to the campus)
